## Amendments Magazine 507

### PATTERN N° 3:

#### Stitches used **Diamonds**

Row 7: k4, \*k2tog, yfwd, k5, yfwd, **sl 1, k1, pssso**, k7\*, rep from \* to \*.

**Pattern stitch** using 3 mm needles **Follow the chart from stitch 1 to 40, rep from stitch 1. After completing Row 40, rep from Row 1.**

#### Back

Row 1-4: Garter st.

Row 5-12: Eyelet st.

Row 13-16: Garter st.

Row 17-28: **Eyelet st.**

Row 29-32: **Garter st.**

**Row 33-60: Diamonds according to the pattern, beg with the following exceptions...**

On completing **Row 60**, work 4 more rows in garter st.

**\*Next row:** Pattern to last 4 (4-5-5) sts, turn.

**Next row:** Pattern to last 4 (4-5-5) sts, turn\*. Rep from \* to \* **3 (8-0-5) times.**

**\*\*Next row:** Pattern to last 3 (3-4-4) sts, turn.

**Next row:** Pattern to last 3 (3-4-4) sts, turn\*\*. Rep from \*\* to \*\* 8 (3-**11**-6) times.

### PATTERN N° 8:

#### Eyelet St:

Row 17 should read: K5, \*yfwd, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, k2tog, yfwd, k1, yfwd, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, k2tog, yfwd, k9\*

Row 41 should read: \*k1, yfwd, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, k2tog, yfwd, k9, yfwd, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, k2tog, yfwd\*

#### Back:

After increasing for armholes you should have 181 (201-221) sts.

#### Front:

Work as for back until measures 40 (43-46) cm from cast on edge. End of row 182 (194-208).

Work in pattern for 81 (88-95) sts, place these sts on a stitch holder. Then place central 19 (25-31) sts on a second stitch holder. Pattern to end.

**\*\*Next row** \*pattern to 4 sts from neck edge and then place these 4 sts on the central stitch holder.

Turn and work to end\* Repeat once.

Then \*pattern to 3 sts from neck edge and then place these 3 sts on the central stitch holder. Turn and work to end\* Repeat 3 times.

Then \*pattern to 2 sts from neck edge and then place these 2 sts on the central stitch holder. Turn and work to end\* Repeat 4 times.

Then \*pattern to 1 st from neck edge and then place this stitch on the central stitch holder. Turn and work to end\* Repeat once.

#### AT THE SAME TIME

When works measures 14 (16-18) cm from beginning of armhole (196-208-222 rows of total height).

Size 1 & 2: Place 7 sts from the armhole edge on a stitch holder, then 6 sts every other row 7 times.  
Size 3: Place 7 sts from the armhole edge on a stitch holder every other row 8 times.  
Size 4: Place 7 sts from the armhole edge on a stitch holder, then 8 sts every other row 7 times. \*\*  
Return to stitches for Left Front and shape as from \*\*to\*\*  
At this point all stitches can then be placed on central stitch holder.

## **PATTERN N° 12:**

### **Stitches used Eyelet Diamond**

Row 35: k3, [p2tog, yfwd] twice, p1, 4FC, k4, **4BC**, p1, [yfwd, p2tog] twice, k3.

Row 39: k3, [p2tog, yfwd] 3 times, p1, 4FC, 4BC, p1, [yfwd, p2tog] 3 times, **k3**.

Row 40: **p3**, [yfwd, k2tog] 4 times, p6, [k2tog, yfwd] 4 times, p3.

## **PATTERN N° 13:**

Pattern Stitch using 4mm needles over a multiple of 8 sts + 4:

Row 1 (rs): p1, k2tog, yfwd, p1, \* cross 2 right (C2R = k into 2<sup>nd</sup> st on needle, then p 1<sup>st</sup> st and slip both lps off needle at same time), cross 2 left (C2L = p 2<sup>nd</sup> st on needles, then k 1<sup>st</sup> at and slip both lps off needle at same time), p1, k2tog, yfwd, p1 \*, rep from \* to \*.

**Row 2 and all even-numbered rows:** k over k, p over p, and k all yfwd lps.

**Row 3:** k2, p1, \* C2R, C2L, p1, k2tog, yfwd, p1 \*, rep from \* to \*, end with k1.

**Row 5:** k1, p1, \* C2R, C2L, p1, k2tog, yfwd, p1 \*, rep from \* to \*, end with k2

**Row 7:** p1, \* \* C2R, C2L, p1, k2tog, yfwd, p1 \*, rep from \* to \*, end with C2R, k1.

**Row 9:** k2, C2L, \* p1, k2tog, yfwd, p1, C2R, C2L \*, rep from \* to \*, end last repeat with k2 instead of C2L.

**Row 11:** k1, C2L, \* p1, k2tog, yfwd, p1, C2R, C2L \*, rep from \* to \*, end with p1.

**Row 13:** k2, \* p1, k2tog, yfwd, p1, C2R, C2L \*, rep from \* to \*, end with p1, k1.

**Row 15:** k1, \* p1, k2tog, yfwd, p1, C2R, C2L \*, rep from \* to \*, end with p1, k2.

**Row 17:** rep from row 1.

**C4B & C4F** should actually be C2B & C2F so slip 1 onto cable needle then K1 instead of 2 sts on each.

## **PATTERN N° 17:**

**Back** Work straight until back measures 12 (12 ½- 12 ½- 13)in [31 (32-32-33)cm] from cast-on edge [end of Row 156 (160- **160**-166)]

**Armholes** = 88(**92-96**-100) sts.

**Front** then work straight until back measures 12 (12 ½- 12 ½- 13)in [31 (32-32-33)cm] from cast-on edge [end of Row 156 (160- **160**-166)]

**Armholes and neck:** Beg with Row 157 (161-~~161~~-167)

## **PATTERN N° 18:**

### **On Right Front:**

Change to 3mm needles and using the method shown below increase as follows:-

(Method of increase: Rib 5, Knit to last 3 sts, Inc into next st, K2)

Size 1: \*Inc 1 st every r.s. row 9 times, then on following 4th row once\* rep from \*to\* 2 times, then inc 1 st every r.s. row 7 times (117 sts)

Size2: \*Inc 1 st every r.s. row 13 times, then on following 4th row once\* rep from \*to\*, then inc 1 st every r.s. row 12 times (132 sts)

Size 3: \*Inc 1 st every r.s. row 7 times, then on following 4th row once\* rep from \*to\* 3 times, then inc 1 st every r.s. row 8 times (142 sts)

Size 4: \*Inc 1 st every r.s. row 14 times, then on following 4th row once\* rep from \*to\*, then inc 1 st every r.s. row 13 times (157 sts)

At 23-24-25-26 cm (84-88-92-96 rows) from beginning cast of at neck edge every r.s. row as follows:

Size 1: 5 sts 6 times, 4 sts 5 times, 3 sts 9 times, 2 sts 11 times

Size 2: 5 sts 8 times, 4 sts 7 times, 3 sts 10 times, 2 sts 8 times

Size 3: 5 sts 8 times, 4 sts 7 times, 3 sts 12 times, 2 sts 9 times

Size 4: 5 sts 11 times, 4 sts 10 times, 3 sts 8 times, 2 sts 9 times

### **AT THE SAME TIME**

Shape armholes as follows by casting off at armhole edge:-

Size1: Cast off 2 sts once, 1 st twice, 1 st every 4th row 5 times. Work 14 rows without shaping of armhole (continuing shaping of neck) then increase 1 st every 4th row 3 times. Work 3 rows without armhole shaping then cast off 2 sts every other row 6 times to shape shoulder.

Size 2: Cast off 2 sts once, 1 st twice, 1 st every 4th row 5 times. Work 18 rows without shaping of armhole (continuing shaping of neck) then increase 1 st every 4th row 3 times. Work 3 rows without armhole shaping then cast off 2 sts every other row 6 times to shape shoulder.

Size 3: Cast off 2 sts once, 1 st 3 times, 1 st every 4th row 6 times. Work 18 rows without shaping of armhole (continuing shaping of neck) then increase 1 st every 4th row 3 times. Work 3 rows without armhole shaping then cast off 2 sts every other row 6 times to shape shoulder.

Size 4: Cast off 2 sts once, 1 st twice, 1 st every 4th row 7 times. Work 20 rows without shaping of armhole (continuing shaping of neck) then increase 1 st every 4th row 3 times. Work 3 rows without armhole shaping then cast off 2 sts every other row 6 times to shape shoulder.

## **PATTERN N° 21:**

### **Left Front :**

Cast on 85-93-101-111 sts on 3mm needles. Work 7cm (26 rows) of K1,P1 rib.

Change to 3.5mm needles and working in st-st continue as follows.

Increase 1 st at the beginning of next r.s. row then every 12th row 4 times.

At the same time

From the 4th row of st-st cast off at the beginning of every w.s. row as follows:

Size 1: 3 sts 4 times, 2 sts 11 times, 1 st 8 times

Size 2: 3 sts 4 times, 2 sts 12 times, 1 st 11 times

Size 3: 3 sts 4 times, 2 sts 13 times, 1 st 13 times

Size 4: 3 sts 4 times, 2 sts 16 times, 1 st 13 times

Then for all sizes cast off 1 st at the beginning of alternate w.s. rows 21 times (i.e. decrease once every 4 rows)

### **Armhole shaping:**

When work measures 32-33-33-34 cm (106-110-110-112 rows) cast off 3 sts at the beginning of next row then cast off at beginning of r.s. rows as follows:

Size 1: Cast off 2 sts twice, 1 st 8 times, 1 st every 4th row 4 times

Size 2: Cast off 2 sts 3 times, 1 st 9 times, 1 st every 4th row 4 times

Size 3: Cast off 2 sts 3 times, 1 st 10 times, 1 st every 4th row 5 times

Size 4: Cast off 2 sts 5 times, 1 st 10 times, 1 st every 4th row 5 times

Then cast off 1 st every 6th row twice on all sizes.

Work 2 rows on the remaining 6-6-8-8 sts then cast off.

## **PATTERN N°22:**

We had a lady who said she was struggling on Row 22 of the Pattern stitch and I know she has now finished it. This is what I wrote to her:-

I've looked at the French version of the pattern & it says exactly the same however, this appears to conflict with the information on the diagram.

I notice for Row 18 the pattern says p1,yfwd,p1,yfwd,p1 (there should then be another yfwd according to diagram) then\* P2tog 6 times, (yfwd, P1) 5 times, yfwd\* rep from \*to\* but only do yfwd,p1 3 times instead of 5 on last pattern.

Then on Row 22 the pattern says p1,yfwd,p1,yfwd,p1 (again according to diagram there should be another yfwd)..

I wondered if you could try using the diagram for lines 18 & 22 and let me know if this works?

This was her reply:-

Thank you for your reply to my query about the tie-front jacket. I did row 18 omitting the yfwd after (yfwd, p1) 5 times and the rest of the pattern appears to work. After row 18 I had 97 stitches and this number enabled row 22 to work out correctly following the written instructions given for it. Hopefully this will be of use to you in case of any other queries.
