PATTERN N° 1:

STITCHES USED

DIAMOND PATTERN using SPORT and 4 mm needles over a multiple of 24 sts + 2:

Row 1 (rs): p2, *2FC (= sl 2 sts on to cable needle in front of work, p1 then k2 from cable needle), p1, 2FC, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, 2BC (= sl 1 st on to cable needle at back of work, k2 then p1 from cable needle), p1, 2BC, p2 *, rep from * to *.

Row 5: k2, * p2, 2FC, p1, 2FC, k1, p2, k1, 2BC, p1, 2BC, p2, k2 *, rep from * to *.

ROW 5: should read : Row 5: k2, * p2, 2FC, p1, 2FC, k1, p2, k1, 2BC, p1, 2BC, p2, k2 *, rep from * to *.

Back:

Using Baleine and 4mm needles cast on 136 (146-156-166) sts and work in 10/6 rib with the following amendments:

Size 1: P9 *K6,P10* rep from *to* until 9 sts rem, P9.

Size 2: K4 *P10,K6* rep from *to* until 4 sts rem, K4.

Size 3: P3 *K6,P10* rep from *to* until 3 sts rem, P3.

Size 4: P8 *K6,P10* rep from *to* until 8 sts rem, P8.

PATTERN N° 6:

Increases should read 3 sts at beg of every r.s. row 3 times then 2 sts at beg of every r.s. row 5 times then 1 st at beg of every r.s. row 6(7-8-9) times.

PATTERN N° 8:

Hood:

.....from cast-on edge [end of Row 46 (48-50-52)] **Next row : k64 (64-66-66)**, cast off 2 sts, k to end.
Work one row straight to centre of hood = **64 (64-66-66) sts on each side.**

Next row : *k2tog, k to end.

Work one row straight.*

Rep from * to * 3 more times. = 60 (60-62-62) sts.

Next row: k3tog (dec 2), k to end.

Work one row straight.

Rep these last 2 rows 4 more times.

Next row: cast off 3 sts, k to end.

Work straight.

At the same time, when hood measures 7 ¼ (7 ½ - 7 ¾ - 8) in [18.5 (19-19.5-20) cm] from cast-on edge....

PATTERN N° 11:

Left Front:

Row 7: Inc 1, *k1, inc 1, rep form * to end of row = 31 sts. Working this row in twisted 1/1 rib, starting with p1. Cont in twisted 1/1 rib to the end of Row 10.

Row 43: work in Twisted 2/1 Rib and Twisted 1/1 Rib, maintaining Twisted Rib as established.

Size 2

Rows 51 to 54: work in Twisted 2/1 Rib and Twisted 1/1 Rib, maintaining Twisted Rib as established.

Size 3 and 4:

Rows 51 to 58 work in Twisted 2/1 Rib and Twisted 1/1 Rib, maintaining Twisted Rib as established.

Upper section:

Beg at shoulder: Using 3.5 mm needles cast on 6 (7-7-8) sts and knit 1 row.

Next row: Cast on 6 (6-7-8) sts, purl to end.

Knit 1 row straight.

Next row: Cast on 5 (6-7-7) sts, purl to end.

Knit 1 row straight.

Next row: Cast on 5 (6-6-7) sts, purl to end. = 22 (25-27-30) sts.

PATTERN N° 13:

Collar: using 5 mm needles, with rs facing and beg at right front neck, pick up 101 (105-109-113) sts and work in 1/1 rib until collar measure **2 in (5cm)** from pick-up row (end of **row 14**).

Collar shaping: The buttonhole should be created at 5cm then work another 15cm - not the other way around as suggested in magazine.

Last paragraph:

Backstitch the side and sleeve seams.

Should read:

Finishing:

Backstitch the side and raglan seams. Cover each button by cutting a 3 1/3 yard (3 m.) length of yarn.

Right front Raglan armhole, buttonhole, and neck:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next ws row.

Work 3 rows straight.

Next ws row: **p4, p2tog**, work to end of row.

PATTERN N° 18:

FINISHING: should read : Backstitch the shoulder seams.

ARMHOLE BORDERS: Using 3 mm needles and, beg on left front armhole edge and ending on left back armhole edge 7 (7-1/2—8-1/4—8-3/4) in [18 (19-21-22) cm] from shoulder seam, pick up 93 (97-107-111) sts around the armhole. Work in 1/1 rib for 6 rows. Cast off. Repeat, beg on right back armhole edge.
